Engineer's Report:

Mr. Bradley reports:

Kleinfelder is working on a cost effectiveness analysis for implementing a solar power generation system at the LTMUA through a conventional design build, rather than a power purchase agreement with a solar developer. Mr. Bradley says the total life cycle cost savings is estimated at 3.3 million (ultra conservative assuming rates do not increase) or 7.3 million over 25 years (assuming utility power costs rates increase 3% per year). Based on the analysis, it will be cost effective and will benefit the LTMUA.

The Effluent Force Main Replacement Project – the formal Pre-construction meeting required by the NJDEP for funded projects took place on December 9, 2020. The attendees for this meeting were: the NJDEP, LTMUA, Tomar Construction, and Kleinfelder. This project will be underway soon, and the estimated completion date is March 11, 2022.
